| <p>5.2. AAAsports complaint with respect to historic judging fines</p> | |
| <p>This was discussed as outlined in email complaint from AAAsports. The fines related to the competition in Penrith. Adam produced evidence of correspondence between him and Emily Morrirt from AAA understanding and accepting that a fine was likely. The information was discussed and it was agreed that the fine was reasonable and should be paid. Adam will contact Andi.</p> | Adam |
| <p>5.3. AAAsports complaint with respect to DMT competition timing</p> | |
| <p>It was noted that it was agreed at a previous committee meeting to hold the DMT competition the evening before trampoline.</p> | |

| <p>Various proposals for accommodating the DMT competition with minimal impact on all clubs was discussed at length. The issue is related to the lack of viable hosts and difficulties getting full panels of judges to run events simultaneously. It was agreed that the DMT competition would remain the night before for regional qualifiers. For the next qualifier in Billingham, Adam will see if it is possible to pull the start time forward by 1 hour.</p> | Adam |
| <i>5.4. Judging</i> | |
| <p>It is unlikely that any judging courses will be run until national level revalidations are held. A discussion took place brainstorming options to improve the outlook. It was agreed that carrot as well as stick would be trialled – if a club is able to supply additional judges that are chosen for panels, then they will be awarded a £60 credit in addition to fining the clubs that are short as per current practices.</p> | |
| <i>5.5. Regional Competitions</i> | |
| <p>If possible, the aim will be to run regional qualifiers on a single day (dependent on hosting clubs and availability of additional judges)</p> | |
| <p>To enable better planning – dates will be agreed up to 1 year ahead with the following as target dates: End February; start of May, Middle of June regional final & club cup; squads July / August; Regional schools December, Zonal schools January. This is dependent on the availability of clubs submitting competition hosting forms.</p> | |
| 6. AOB | |
| <i>6.1. Northern Closed</i> | |
| <p>Aiming to hold the competition 12&13 November. Bids are invited for hosting – due ASAP (6 April). Note that Velocity is unable to host on that date. The minimum requirement is for 2 days of competition with 6 trampolines + DMT.</p> | |
| <p>Mens and Ladies requirements were agreed as 2 voluntary routines, minimum DD 6.5.</p> | |
| <p>Finals for championships only.</p> | |
| <i>6.2. Squads</i> | |
| <p>The interregional final is planned for 3&4 September in Sheffield. The plan is to arrange squad dates for those selected. They will need to attend at least 1 date. Those selected will need to order (and pay) for kit within 2 weeks. Dates for squads: 3 July & 21 August</p> | |
| <p>Kit was discussed. It may be difficult to get kit from the current supplier in time – if anyone is interested in changing leotards and kit, please put a proposal together and forward to the NETTC Exec.</p> | All |
| <p>We are seeking people who are interested in becoming squad coaches or the squad director. Please let the NETTC Exec know if you are interested and available for the dates above as well as the competition.</p> | All |
