Competitors represent the North of England region at the competition, not their club. The North of England will cover the region wide cost of entry which covers judges and the cost of sending squad coaches, who are volunteers, to the competition. Competitors need to pay their entry fee (£50 for one discipline, £67.50 for two), a deposit for the compulsory squad kit (which is a North of England leotard and t-shirt at £40.50 for 28-32s and £43.50 for 34+) plus transaction fees online at www.nettc.org.uk/shop no later than Sunday 3rd July. Regional squad hoodies will be available as an optional extra. If competitors do not pay their entry fee online by this date their space may be forfeit and the next ranked gymnast invited to replace them in the squad.

To climatise the competitors to working with regional squad coaches, rather than their personal coaches, there will be two regional squad training sessions held at Velocity, Billingham, TS233HB. The first is Sunday 3rd July and the second is Sunday 21st August. All DMT competitors, regional 1 trampoline competitors and disabilities trampoline competitors will train 9:30-11:00 and all regional 2, 3 and 4 competitors will train 11:00-12:30. Competitors must attend at least one of the regional squad training sessions to work with the coaches who will be with them at the competition.
